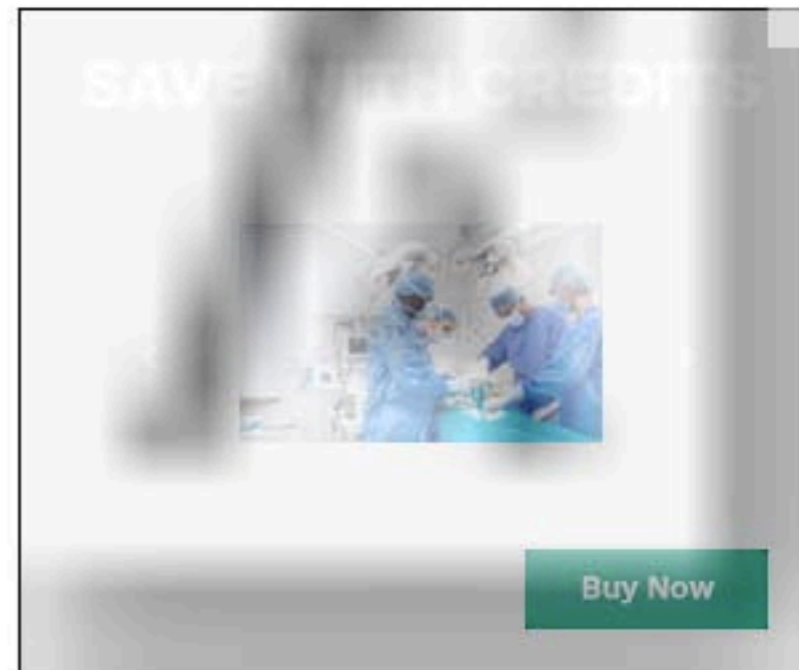

'Property guardian' cheap rent scheme on way to NI

A novel Dutch property scheme that enables people to live in unoccupied buildings in exchange for looking after the place is heading to Northern Ireland. The 'property guardian' concept has seen offices, warehouses, convents and even pubs turned into temporary low cost accommodation. Camelot Property Management, which has utilised buildings across Europe by filling the empty space with people looking for affordable housing, is setting up in Northern Ireland.
